CHAPTER 267, LAWS OF NEW YORK 2002

AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system as the "U.S. Army 77th Infantry Division Expressway"

Became a law July 30, 2002, with the approval of the Governor. Passed by a majority vote, three-fifths being present.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 343-o to read as follows:

§ 343-O. PORTION OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM TO BE DESIGNATED AS THE "U.S. ARMY 77TH INFANTRY DIVISION EXPRESSWAY". ALL THAT PORTION OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM WHICH IS IDENTIFIED AND KNOWN AS THE CLEARVIEW EXPRESSWAY (INTERSTATE 295), SHALL BE DESIGNATED AND KNOWN AS THE "U.S. ARMY 77TH INFANTRY DIVISION EXPRESSWAY".

§ 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the installation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid possible confusion and to limit any possible disruption in commerce, the designation called for pursuant to this act shall be one of ceremonial nature and the official name of such expressway shall not be changed as a result of this act.

§ 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
